

Do you have a project that is complex or requires multiple environmental approvals? If so, a Business Relationship Manager (BRM) with Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change (ECC) may be able to help. They are available to help you understand the environmental regulatory approval process applicable to your business' project.

This next-level support is designed for complex projects, such as:

- multiple permitting requirements or program needs;
- energy-generating facilities;
- green technology projects (e.g. hydrogen production);
- those that support sustainable economic growth.

What can I expect when I reach out to a BRM?

A BRM will answer your questions about the environmental regulatory pathway – depending on the size, location and activities associated with your project, it may require an environmental assessment approval, operational approvals, or both – a BRM will help determine what is required.

Once you know what approvals are required, a BRM will provide helpful resources to support the approval processes for your project. As needed, BRMs can connect you with departmental staff who process applications in the Inspection Compliance and Enforcement Division and staff in the Environmental Assessment branch.

You can continue to connect with a BRM throughout the application process and post approval, depending on your project's complexity. They can help ensure you understand the requirements of your approval, and coordinate with staff and other agencies, as needed.
