Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors

Nova Scotia College of Counselling Therapists

Nova Scotia College of Dietitians and Nutritionists

Nova Scotia College of Dispensing Opticians

<u>Nova Scotia College of Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Professionals</u> (regulates <u>therapists</u> and technologists working in sonography, radiography, nuclear medicine, MRI, and radiation therapy)

Nova Scotia College of Medical Laboratory Technologists

Nova Scotia College of Nursing (regulates LPNs, RNs, and NPs)

Nova Scotia College of Optometrists

Nova Scotia College of Pharmacists (also regulates pharmacy technicians)

Nova Scotia College of Physiotherapists

Nova Scotia College of Respiratory Therapists

Nova Scotia Regulator of Paramedicine
